It was sold to a private collector from Geneve, Switzerland 2.024











When you step into "**Pisco y Nazca**" restaurant in Bethesda, MD, you feel it immediately: the hum of voices, the warmth of shared food, and — if you look up — a pattern of color and movement floating lightly above the main dining room.

These ceiling panels aren't simply decoration. They're a kinetic chromatic abstraction of La Chacana — the Andean Cross. For more than 4,000 years, this symbol has guided communities across the Andes, reminding us that life's visible layers are always connected to an invisible order.



### Roberto Sayas Biography — UK - Awarded kinetic artist | Based in Vigo, Spain

Sayas creates kinetic art that lives and breathes by universal laws.

His work explores the interplay between color and light, structure and fluidity, inviting viewers into moments of stillness made dynamic.

Rooted in his Venezuelan and Peruvian heritage, Sayas blends cultural rhythms with mathematical elegance.

His compositions—often grounded in the golden ratio—are both precise and poetic, reimagining geometric abstraction as a sensory experience.

His pieces, crafted through innovative techniques like 3D wood construction, acrylic aerography, and UV printing, are not static visuals.

They unfold through time, light, and perception—transforming spaces, resonating with the people who live and move within them.

In 2022, Sayas was recognized as a Highly Commended Exhibitor in the UK Visual Artists Association's Professional Artist of the Year Award. His work has been featured in exhibitions across Europe and the Americas, including Red Dot Miami. His dynamic compositions captivated audiences with their magnetic, ever-shifting imagery.



In 2024, his voice and insight were featured in the VAA UK publication "Securing Gallery Representation" where he offered guidance to fellow artists navigating the contemporary art world.

Roberto Sayas's art invites you not just to look, but to listen—because sometimes, it's the colors that are speaking. And within that dialogue, there is always movement, and there is always meaning.
